At approximately 11:40 p.m. Thursday evening officers responded to a domestic disturbance in the 1100 block of Raritan in Rock Hill.

Upon responding to this call Officer Matthew Crosby age 30 was shot in the shoulder with a bullet passing through his body and coming to rest on his spine.

The surgery to remove the bullet was successful and he is presently in stable condition. He was conscious and coherent before he went into surgery and presently recovering.

The suspect is believed to have moved here three months ago from Tennessee. The report of the suspect's condition has been reported as "Poor".

The investigation has been formally turned over to the St. Louis County Police. Further questions regarding this investigation should be directed to the St. Louis County Police Department.
