The St. Louis County expansion is designed to help meet the transportation needs of St. Louis County seniors (age 60+) and visually impaired adults (21+) within a designated service area for any reason. Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, ITN offers riders the maximum in choice and freedom through paid and volunteer drivers. ITN offers dignified transportation—and peace of mind to families.

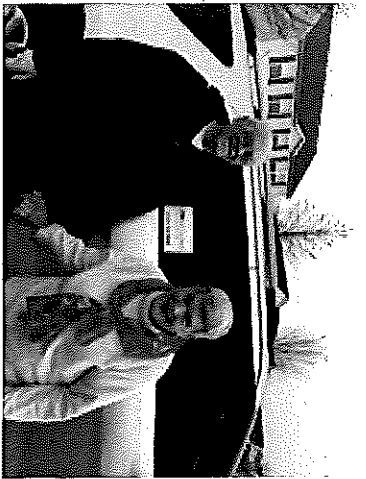

ITN Services:

Personal transportation in private vehicles. Our Door-through-Door, Arm-through-Arm rides are provided by caring, trained volunteers or ITN drivers

Complete application and set-up your transportation account to begin riding with us. Applications are available online or by calling the office.

ITN Ride Service Area:

ITN Rider Benefits and Criteria:

Annual Administration Fee (\$50 individual or \$75 couple) & Transportation Accounts allow ride scheduling and travel without worrying about paying as you go.

Affordable, Safe, Trusted Transportation:

Very affordable! Ride costs are based on \$1.50 per mile, plus a \$2.50 pickup fee if booked by 3:00 PM the day prior. Absolutely NO TIPPING and NO CASH TRANSACTIONS.
