

ROCK HILL PARKS and RECREATION MINUTES
FROM MAY 19, MEETING

The May meeting was held at Whitfield Park.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by the president of the commission at 6:30 pm.

OLD BUSINESS

Greenwood Park Update

The commission was informed that it appears there are no current easements or agreements regarding the use of Greenwood Park. The commission was also informed of the city attorney's recommendations as to how to proceed with this issue. The commission agreed that the best way to proceed was to obtain an easement without having a survey done on the property. The director was asked to contact the city administrator and city attorney to move forward with the process.

MOVIE NIGHT

The commission was updated on the status of the movie night which is to be held this Saturday. Everything was ready to go however, there is a good chance of rain on Saturday night. The event will be moved to the Clean Cut Creation building if it does rain.

NEW BUSINESS

WHITFIELD PARK

The Whitfield Park improvement plan was reviewed by the commission. They were reminded that the \$3,000 budget was for material only and did not include labor costs. The commission was pleased with the overall plan and agreed that some minor changes to the plan could be made if necessary. The commission felt that this would be a good project to do in the fall and that it would make for an excellent community volunteer event. The commission set a date of Saturday, October 15 as the planting date. More discussion of event details will be discussed.

FALL FESTIVAL

The commission was informed that the Board of Aldermen voted to move the Fall Festival to Saturday, October 1st. Other possible changes include moving the event to a different site, possibly the Market at McKnight development and include a Taste of Rock

Hill as part of the event. There would still be a parade and entertainment included in the Fall Festival.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The commission was informed that the newsletter has been published. They were also informed that registrations for Summer Day Camp and the swimming program with Maplewood were starting to come in.
