

ROCK HILL PARKS and RECREATION MINUTES  
FROM JUNE 16, 2011 MEETING

The June meeting was held at Hensley Park.

Call to Order: the meeting was called to order by the president of the commission at 6:30 pm.

Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting

OLD BUSINESS

GREENWOOD PARK UPDATE

The commission was informed that the city attorney is working on the easement for the property at 305 Eldridge. Once the easement document is completed, it will be presented to the Board of Aldermen for their approval and then submitted to Mr. and Mrs. Cooper for their signatures. Once the signatures have been obtained, the easement will be filed with St. Louis County.

MOVIE NIGHT RECAP

The commission was given a recap of the movie night program. Overall, the event went well. The weather was good, and there was a good walk up crowd for the movie. There were 17 vehicles at the car show. The Clean Cut Creation staff was expecting more, however, there was a threat of rain all day and that may have kept some of the cars away. Attendance was estimated between 75-100. Our next movie night will be October 15 at the Clean Cut Creations shop located at 950 Des Peres Avenue. The movie for this event is Ghostbusters. Continuing this co-sponsorship next year will be discussed among all parties after the October movie.

WHITFIELD PARK PROJECT

Details for this project were discussed. The area to be planted first will be the smaller area closest to Berry Avenue. A temporary safety fence will need to be installed along Berry Road. The area will also need to be tilled before the planting is done. Hot dogs and refreshments will be provided to volunteers. The commission members will recruit volunteers and the director will contact the local scout troop for their assistance. The event will also be publicized in the next newsletter, the city's website and Facebook page.

NEW BUSINESS

SUMMER DAY CAMP UPDATE

The commission was given current attendance figures for the camp. As of June 16 there were 33 children registered. The camp will start on June 20 and run through July 28.

CITY WIDE GARAGE/YARD SALE

The director proposed offering a city wide garage/yard sale for the residents of Rock Hill. The commission felt this was a good idea and worth a try.
