The summary report will include background on how the plan was developed, implementation strategies and possible funding sources.

NEW BUSINESS

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The commission was reminded that National Night Out will be held Tuesday, August 2. They were also informed that there will be an event at Stroup Field this year hosted by Geoff George and Alderman Scherry.
