

ROCK HILL PARKS and RECREATION MINUTES  
FROM APRIL 21 MEETING

The April meeting was held at Greenwood Park.

Call to order: The meeting was called to order by the vice-president of the commission at 6:30 pm.

Approval of minutes from March meeting: A motion to approve the March minutes was made by Ballard and seconded by Christiansen. The motion was approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Greenwood Park Update

The commission was informed that the property owner at 305 Eldridge was willing to allow the park shelter to be built on the property that overlaps the park. The question of whether there needs to be a survey and easement given to the city or if just a written agreement will suffice needs to be determined. The director will discuss this with the city administrator and city attorney. The details of the construction project such as starting dates and equipment were also discussed. A motion was made by Christiansen to ask Mr. Cooper, the property owner at 305 Eldridge if there was someone he would like to dedicate the shelter to for his willingness to work with the city. The dedication name would be subject to the approval of the commission. The motion was seconded by Kachulis. The motion passed.

Walking Biking Master Plan

The commission was informed that the final public forum for the Walking/Biking Master Plan will be held Tuesday, April 26 at 7:00 pm at Steger School.

Movie Night

The commission was updated on the Rock Hill Movie Night scheduled for Saturday May 21 at Stroup Field. The plans are progressing well however, volunteers are needed. The pre movie events are scheduled to start at 5:30 and the movie will start around 8:15.

Tree City USA and Easter Program Recap

Members of the police and fire departments also attended the ceremony.

We had 31 children attend the Easter program. We had the Easter egg hunt in the gym due to inclement weather, but it went just fine. Staff from Boulevard Bank helped with the event.
