Old Business:

Movie Night Rescheduling

New Business:

Plant Swap

The director informed the commission that he met with a resident that was interested in organizing a citywide plant swap. The tentative plan would be to hold this event in the spring, possibly in conjunction with the Arbor Day/Tree City USA program. The commission thought this was an excellent idea and should be pursued. Will mentioned that his wife has been involved in plant swaps and would ask her for details on how hers were organized.

City Wide Recycling

Peggy brought up the idea of organizing a city wide recycling event in the near future. The commission thought this would be a good program for our residents. Details would need to be worked out to coordinate with various recyclers. Alderman Scherry emailed the commission members suggesting that this event could possibly be done in conjunction with the Fall Festival. The director said he would present this to the Fall Festival committee.
