OLD BUSINESS

GREENWOOD PARK

The commission was informed that Miracle Recreation will be removing the existing playground equipment and installation will be gin as soon as the old equipment is gone. Once the playground equipment is installed, the shelter will then be installed. Alderman Johnson then addressed the commission regarding the condition of Greenwood Park. He showed pictures of weeds growing in the park and wanted to make sure the commission was aware of this and the lack of maintenance the park was receiving. The commission agreed with Alderman Johnson that this needed to be addressed so that this does not happen in the future. The commission directed the director to meet with the public works superintendent to make sure that this issue is addressed and that the park receive proper maintenance. Also discussed was the idea of a dedication ceremony in late October once the project is completed and holding next year's Arbor Day/Tree City USA program in Greenwood Park.

PARK BUILDING

The contract for demolition has been signed and returned. We are now waiting for a project schedule and certificate of insurance from the contractor. Once these items have been submitted a date for demolition can be set.

CITY WIDE GARAGE SALE
