DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The commission was also updated on the RainScape Rebate program and the new program provided by the new trash service. This program gives the city ½ of the proceeds from recycling revenue generated by the trash service. The use of these funds will be determined by the Board of Aldermen. Lastly, the commission was informed that after many years, we will be receiving four free bicycle racks. Trailnet took over this project from the St. Louis Bicycle Federation and was finally able to procure the racks.
