Minutes for the Board of Aldermen meeting,
Tuesday, July 21, 2020
7:00 p.m.**

1. Mayor Mahan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. The Mayor called the roll and the following members of the Aldermanic Board were in attendance: Alderman Took Alderman Wofford, Alderman Westfall, and Alderman Rappold.

The motion was approved unanimously by voice vote. Alderman Westfall moved and Alderman Wofford seconded a motion to appoint Alderman Johnson as liaison to the Community Development Commission. The motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.
