- 1. Mayor Mahan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2. The Mayor called the roll and the following members of the Aldermanic Board were in attendance: Alderman took, Alderman Davis, Alderman Weider, and Alderman Wiley. Alderman Johnson and Alderman Westfall were both absent.
- 3. Citizens to Address the Board:
