Minutes for the Board of Aldermen meeting,
Tuesday,
December 4, 2018
7:00 p.m.**

1. Mayor Mahan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. The Mayor called the roll and the following members of the Aldermanic Board were in attendance: Mr. James Killion, Mr. Ed Johnson, Ms. Mary Wofford, and Ms. Jackie Rappold. Ms. Sabrina Westfall and Mr. Robert Weider were absent.
3. **Citizens to Address the Board:** none
4. **Announcements, Presentations, Proclamations, Communications & Invitations:** Linda Jones from Waste Connection gave a presentation about recycling.
5. **Minutes of Previous Meeting** – November 20, 2018: Alderman Wofford moved and Alderman Killion seconded a motion to approve the minutes for the November 20, 2018 meeting. The motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.
