- a) **Bill No. 1968:** AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ROCK HILL MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE CITY BY AMENDING SECTION 320.040 “GENERAL SPEED LIMIT” AND REPEALING AND REPLACING SCHEDULE II “SPEED LIMITS”.

City Attorney Paul Martin read **Bill No. 1968** for the second time by “title” only.

Alderman Wofford moved and Alderman Weider seconded a motion to approve **Bill No. 1968**.

The Board of Aldermen discussed amendments to exclude certain streets. The Board of Aldermen voiced their views for and against **Bill No. 1968**. Alderman Weider moved to amend **Bill No. 1968**. The Bill was amended by a 4-2 vote in favor.

Alderman Wofford moved and Alderman Weider seconded a motion to approve **Bill No 1968** as amended.

Those members of the Board voting in favor of **Bill No. 1968** were Alderman Weider, Alderman Davis, Alderman Wofford, and Alderman Westfall. Those members of the Board opposed were Alderman Johnson and Alderman Rappold.
