Old Business: Hudson Playground Project: The Playground committee has decided to wait a year to apply for the Muni grant. Parks and Recreation Superintendent is hoping to meet with Unlimited Play this summer and hopes to get in touch with Warson Woods about possibly partnering in the project.

New Business:

- Two residents have reached out to possibly donate trees in memory of their family members to Hensley Park. The Commission recalls trees being donated in the past but doesn't recall a set price. The Parks and Recreation Superintendent with the Public Works Director will work on an outline with suggested prices to give the residents the opportunity to donate.
- Day Camp will run out of Oakhaven Park this summer and will run one week later, June 8-July 16. The Commission discussed the lack of shelter in the event of bad weather. Camp will run similar to Camp Webegee in Webster, Parents will be required to pick up campers in the event of bad weather.
- The company painting the lines at the Oakhaven Park Tennis Courts will come back to repaint two of the Pickleball courts with a brighter color. They have us on their schedule but need a few days of nice weather before they can paint the lines.
- Summer Plans include celebrating National Parks and Recreation month in July with daily activities. Those will be posted on the website and on Facebook.
