## **BICYCLIST SAFETY**

Bicyclists are asked to adopt these safe riding practices:



Assure bicycle readiness. Check your



Always wear a helme



Wear bright clothing.



While riding at night, wear a light.



Do not wear more than one earphone



Stay hydrated at all



Yield to pedestrians.



Use hand signals when turning or stopping.



Obey traffic signs.

## STATISTICS from the CDC

- $\bullet \ \, \text{Each year, nearly 1,000 bicyclists die on our nation's roads in crashes involving a motor vehicle.}$
- There are also an estimated 120,000 emergency department visits of bicyclists treated for nonfatal crash-related injuries annually.
- Bicycle trips make up 1% of all trips in the United States. However, bicyclists account for 2–3% of people who die in a crash involving a motor vehicle on US roads.
- Most bicyclist deaths occur in urban areas
- A helmet can help protect you from a serious brain or head injury.
