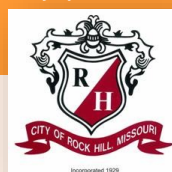

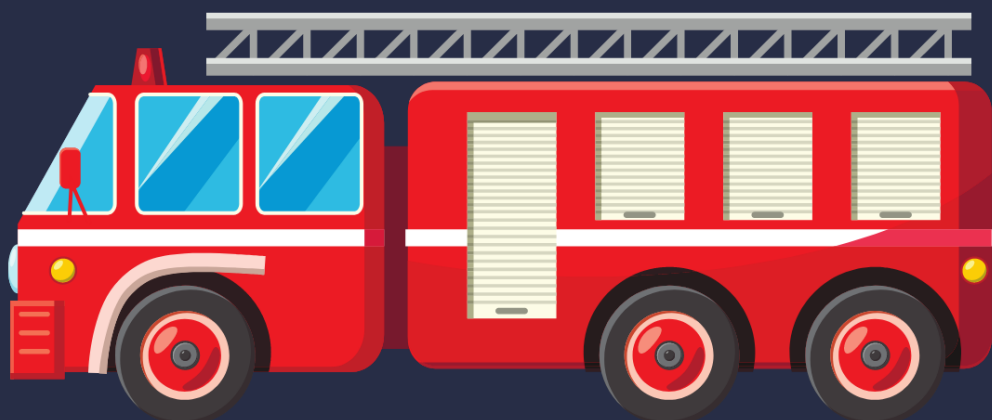

01.

Dress Light
Remember to wear lightweight, light-colored, loose fitting clothing.

02.

Drink plenty of fluids
Stay away from sugary or alcoholic drinks.

03.

Keep Cool
Stay inside in an air-conditioned place as much as possible.

04.

Sunscreen
Sunscreen protects the skin from UV rays, decreasing the risk of sun damage to the skin.

05.

Neighbors
Check on those at risk, like the sick, older adults, pregnant women and children

Road Work Updates

The Missouri Department of Transportation will be closing the intersection of N. Sappington Road and Manchester Road beginning at 7 pm, Friday, July 21, 2023. While the closure is in place, eastbound and westbound Manchester Road will remain open; however, there will be no access to Manchester Road from N. Sappington Road. MoDOT’s contractors will be working 24-hours a day while the intersection is closed to complete the necessary work and will re-open the intersection by 7 pm, Sunday, July 23, 2023.

The Public Works Department is currently working on Merritt Ave. They are starting on the Bremerton Road side and working towards Creve Coeur Dr. They will be doing the North Side first and then the South Side. Construction has started on the new houses being built on Merritt Ave and while the crew plans to complete the section of Merritt in front of the houses they are waiting until the houses are closer to being complete to finish that area.

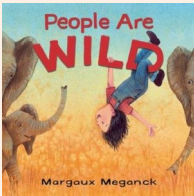


Happy *National Grilling & Culinary Arts Month* from your friends at **Rock Hill Public Library!**
