Dear Residents of Rock Hill,  
April is quickly approaching and with it the Municipal Election on Tuesday, April 2. If you are interested in seeing the sample ballot, you can enter your address in the St. Louis County website by clicking [HERE](#). On the ballot you will see the Alderperson election in your Ward, as well as two Propositions from the Metropolitan Sewer District. St. Louis County is allowing you to vote at any polling place again for this election and will be updating the Line Tracker so you can find the best time to go. For the Line Tracker website, click [HERE](#). Make sure to get out and vote! As a reminder, the Ward map was updated late last year in response to the most recent census results. A copy of the new map is included below. We have received and approved the first round of plans for Lava Island. They will now need approval from St. Louis County. Lava Island is an indoor play center offering trampolines, foam pits and other amenities. They plan to open at the Market at McKnight this summer.

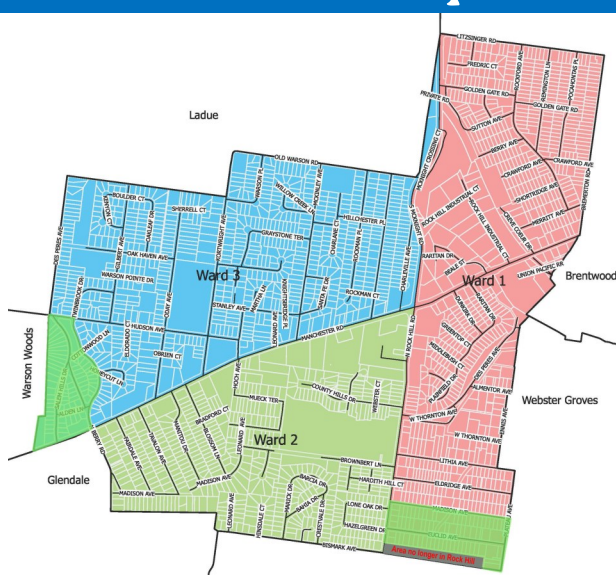
