The Shepherd's Center of Webster-Kirkwood is part of a national network of 55 centers. Since 1998, we have helped older adults to find enrichment, maintain independence and stay socially active. Over 300 volunteers help us fulfill our mission. We need you!

HOW WE SERVE OUR CLIENTS:

- Free rides to medical appointments
- Ambulatory (no wheelchairs) older adults aged 55+
- Tuesdays, Wednesday, Thursdays: 9am to 3 pm
- Service area boundaries apply
- Round-trip, *door-through-door* service (Volunteers walk riders from the parking lot to their appointments, wait until appointment is finished and drive them home afterwards)

INTERESTED IN JOINING THE TEAM?

- Complete an application and online background check
- Attend one orientation meeting
- Once approved, sign-up for rides using our online *RideScheduler* system (or via telephone if you prefer)
- Minimum of one drive per month
