A Letter from the Mayor Dear Residents of Rock Hill, Thank you to everyone who joined us




for the "Push-In" Ceremony to get the new fire truck into service.

The City of Rock Hill and Lochmueller Group will be holding a virtual public meeting to discuss recommended improvements in accordance with the Rock Hill Stormwater Master Plan (SWMP). The plan is aimed at identifying, prioritizing, and guiding project implementation strategies for stormwater related Capital Improvement Projects (CIPs) in the City of Rock Hill.

At the meeting, a presentation will be given to explain the Stormwater Master Plan, and exhibits will be shown which illustrate the recommended improvements. This will be followed by a question-and-answer portion of the meeting. You will be able to submit questions via the Q&A function if you are joining on a computer or tablet. 
corn and refreshments included. (PG-13). Upcoming movies include *Last Christmas (December 12)* and *New Year's Eve (December 26).*
