Daylight Saving Time Ends Sunday, November 7

Check your smoke detectors and don't forget to change the **batteries** when you change your clocks. Double check your escape plan should a fire occur. Take some time to prepare your home:



Change your clocks. Check your batteries.



- * Clean around your furnace.
- * Clean around your hot water heater.
- * Have your Fireplace checked.



In order to accommodate the new 988 National Suicide Hotline certain area codes within the US will need to start using all 10 digits in a phone number (area code + phone number) to make local calls within the area code. In Missouri the affected area codes are 314, 417, 660, and

816. In Illinois the affected area codes are 618, 309, and 708.

The need to use all 10 digits will begin on October 24, 2021.

Manchester Road Construction Update

Between Big Bend and Lindbergh

From Missouri Department of Transportation:

Our utility partners are still working along the corridor to move their utilities out of the construction zone. Most of that is currently in the west end of the project, and much of that work is being done at night.



Crews are working on removing sidewalks and constructing new entrances along the stretch of Manchester between Big Bend and Hanley. That work is primarily during the day. Within the next couple of weeks, work will start on some sewer system updates at Mary Avenue, during the day. Drivers can expect lane closures and shifts along Mary Avenue, Dorothy and Van Mark Way once work starts until about mid-December.

We do anticipate that crews will start work on sidewalks and new entrances on the western portion of the project near Lindbergh just before November. That work is also at night, to avoid significant impacts to businesses and to the heavier levels of traffic in that area.
